5. Participation qualifications

Athletes must be minimum age of 30 years by year of birth, born in 1986 or before.

Hold a National Federation's membership currently affiliated to the IJF.

Hold minimum 1st Kyu.

Athletes must not have represented a National Team in a competition at international senior level at any time in the twelve month period before the start date of this







particular Japan Veteran International Judo Championships i.e. between 18th June 2015 and 17th June 2016.

8. Control of entries and registration

Entries should be submitted by the National Federation. However, in the case of any difficulty in arrangements entries will be accepted through clubs or even individuals. Passport or photocopy of passport must be available during the registration.

9. Competition Rules

Competition will be carried out according to the IJF Referee Rules specially adopted to this tournament.

<Individual>

The winner will be decided by Yuko or above, or 1 Shido Difference.

If there is no difference between two athletes at the end of the competition, the winner will be decided by flag decision (There is no Golden Score for all age divisions).

Female: -48 kg; -52 kg; -57 kg; -63 kg; -70 kg; -78 kg; +78 kg Male: -60 kg; -66 kg; -73 kg; -81 kg; -90 kg; -100 kg; +100 kg

*The organizer may combine two or more categories depending on the number of athletes.

<TEAM>

The winner will be decided by Yuko or above, or 2 Shido Difference.

If there is no difference between two athletes at the end of the competition, the result will be 'Hikiwake' (draw). (No Golden Score System)

The winner team will be decided by the number of victories.

If there is no difference between two teams, the winner will be decided the numbers of Ippon.

If there is still no difference, the winner will be decided the numbers of Waza Ari.

If there is still no difference, the winner will be decided the numbers of Yuko.

If there is still no difference, an extra match between 1 selected representative from each teams will be conducted to decide the winner. The duration of this match is 2 minutes and if there is no difference at the end, the winner will be decided by flag decision.

Female team

Team consists of 3 athletes.

There is no age and weight limit.

Duration is 2.5 min and the order is from youngest athlete.

Male team

Team consists of 5 athletes and the order of each age category is as follows.is from each following age category.

There is no weight limit.

1st	30-39	2.5 min
$2^{ m nd}$	40-49	2.5 min
3rd	50-59	2.5 min
$4^{ m th}$	60-69	2.5 min
$5^{ m th}$	70 over	2 min

If there is no athlete who satisfies one of the age categories of your team, an athlete from one older age category can fill the spot. However no one can replace the age 70 over category.

<Kata>

Competition will be carried out of following kata. Nage no Kata/ Katame no Kata/ Kime no Kata / Ju no Kata Kodokan Goshinjutsu / Itsutsu no Kata/ Koshiki no Kata







Athletes can apply a maximum of 2 different Kata.

The organizer will provide Kime no Kata and Kodokan Goshinjutsu's Weapons.

Competition will be carried out according to IJF Kata Rules.

10. Weigh in

Weigh in for individual competition will be held as follow and all athletes for the individual must attend the weigh in with accreditation card.

*18th Jun (Sat) 15:00-18:00 at Kodokan

11. Judogi

Athlete must have back number with name and country.

Judogi shall only be white and the size must conform to the current regulations. Judogi control with Sokuteiki will be conducted.

12. Insurance

Athletes themselves, athletes and team officials, must assume all responsibility for accident and health insurance as well as the civil liabilities (third party cover). They must have insurance either held personally in the form of specific insurance cover or travel cover (which does not exclude participating in judo competition) or as part of their National Federation insurance arrangements. Neither Organizing office nor All Japan Judo Federation will not be responsible of any claims of illness, Injury and death, of any participants/officials.

13. Visa

For nations which require a Visa to enter Japan, please fill in the Visa application form and send us by e-mail.

14. Anti-doping control

The Organizer has strong anti-doping policy, but there will be no anti-doping control at this Championships.

15. Particular rules for female athletes

The Female athletes must wear a white plain t-shirt. Long hair has to be bounded with an elastic band. Wearing Make-up or accessories is prohibited. The nails have to be cut short.

16. Important information

a) All medalists must attend the medal ceremony with full white Judogi.

b) All athletes should be available to compete at least 45 minutes prior to the estimated start time.
